ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 01

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINES ON CALDWELL LAKE, PEND OREILLE COUNTY, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that Caldwell Lake, Section 2, Township 36 N, Range 43 EWM, is only seventeen (17) acres in size; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that Caldwell Lake does not have a consistent inflow or outflow; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that any fuel or oil spillage will be harmful to Caldwell Lake's water quality.

NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PEND OREILLE COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. In order to preserve the scenic quality, peace, and tranquility, and to protect and preserve the wildlife, to increase visitor safety, and to limit the degradation of lake water quality, the use of internal combustion engines on Caldwell Lake is prohibited,

2. Any person who violates the provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be fined in a sum not to exceed three-hundred dollars (\$300.00).


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this ordinance shall become effective five days after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
