ORDINANCE NO. 2012-

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE *VOLUNTARY*STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM (RCW 36.70A.705)

WHEREAS: the Washington State Legislature, through ESHB 1886, created a Voluntary

Stewardship Program ("VSP") for protection of critical areas in areas of

agricultural activities; and

WHEREAS: ESHB 1886, as codified in RCW 36.70A.710, states that "As an alternative to

protecting critical areas in areas used for agricultural activities through development regulations adopted under RCW 36.70A.060, the legislative authority of a county may elect to protect such critical areas through the

program."; and

WHEREAS: in order to participate in the VSP, the legislative authority of a county must elect

to participate by January 22, 2012; and

WHEREAS: prior to electing to participate in the VSP, a county is required to (a) confer with

tribes, and environmental and agricultural interests; and (b) provide notice following the public participation and notice provisions of RCW 36.70A.035 to

property owners and other affected and interested individuals, tribes,

government agencies, businesses, school districts, and organizations; and

WHEREAS: Pend Oreille County, provided public notice in the *Newport Miner*, and mailed the

public hearing notice to property owners and other affected and interested individuals, tribes, government agencies, businesses, school districts, and

organizations and

WHEREAS: after due notice, the Pend Oreille County Board of County Commissioners held a

public hearing JAN 17, 2012, to hear testimony and take public

comment regarding Pend Oreille County electing to participate in the VSP; and

WHEREAS: on Junuary 17, 2012, the Pend Oreille County Board of Commissioners

deliberated on this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED That the Pend Oreille County Board of Commissioners hereby:

1.	Elects to have Pend Oreille County participate in the Voluntary Stewardship Program.
2.	Identifies the entire country of Fend Oreelle
	watershed for participation in the Voluntary Stewardship Program.
3.	Nominates the <u>WRIA-62</u> for consideration by the State Conservation Commission as state priority watersheds.
4.	Elects to have Pend Oreille County proceed as required by ESHB 1886, as current codified in RCW 36.70A, to implement the requirements of the <i>Voluntary Stewardshiprogram</i> once the Washington State Legislature provides adequate funding for succeptivity.
