PROPOSITION 1

SELKIRK SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 070
MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION REPLACEMENT LEVY

The Board of Directors of Selkirk School District No. 070 adopted Resolution No. 05-06/01, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to meet the educational needs of its students by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational maintenance and operation expenses:
