#### Special Election - Proposition No.1 Library Operations and Maintenance

The Pend Oreille County Library District Board of Trustees adopted Resolution 2019-01 concerning an increase to its regular property tax levy. This proposition would provide continued funding for normal operations and maintenance of library services. The proposition authorizes an increase to the District's regular property tax levy, from \$0.37 to \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation, to be collected in 2020. This levy amount would be used to compute the limitations for subsequent levies as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
